H-239 is equipped with a computer, projector, document camera, Apple TV and A/V system with sound. The projection surface is also a whiteboard and can be written on using dry erase markers.

- The computer is located on the wall mounted adjustable instructor station.
- If the computer screen is blank, move the mouse to wake it up. If it does not respond, press the power button located on the front of the computer.
- Log in by typing your network name and password.
- REMEMBER TO LOG OUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED.

The controls for the **projector power**, **volume** and **input source** are located on the wall to the left of the wall mounted instructor station.

If you wish to connect other devices to the projector, use the HDMI cable at the station and press the **Laptop** button




on the controller. Adapters for most model laptops are attached to the HDMI cable.

The wall mounted instructor station can be adjusted to your desired height and position.

Additional **USB ports** can be located on the left side of the computer screen.
