L-116 is equipped with a computer, projector, document camera, microphone, Apple TV, Blu-Ray player and an Audio/Video system with sound. The projection surface is also a whiteboard and can be written on using a dry erase marker.

- The **COMPUTER** is located behind the monitor.
- If the computer screen is blank, move the mouse to wake it up. If it does not respond, press the power button located on the front of the computer.
- Log in by typing your network name and password.
- REMEMBER TO LOG OUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED.

The controls for the **projector power**, **volume** and **input source** are located on the wall behind the instructor console.

If you wish to connect other devices to the projector, use the HDMI cable on the console and press the **HDMI** button on the controller.




Adapters for most model laptops are attached to the HDMI cable.

Additional **USB ports** can be located on the left side of the computer screen and on the PC located behind the monitor.

Detailed instruction on how to use the document camera and microphone for Zoom or other remote presentations can be found on a separate instruction sheet.

The **Blu-Ray** player is located below the surface on a shelf inside the equipment rack.

Additional **120v** receptacles can be found in the equipment rack below the below the work surface.
