



How Much Do FCC Career-Program Graduates Earn?

Each year, about one third of the credit students are enrolled in career-related programs. The pre- and post- annual median salary of FCC career program graduates demonstrates the importance of obtaining a degree at FCC. As can be seen in the chart in FY 2010 students made a little over double the income three years after graduating that they did one year prior to graduation.



To address current and future workforce demands of the region, the College has adopted many new initiatives to offer more career majors with a variety of formats such as AA, certificate, and letter of recognition. In addition, the College expanded its educational opportunities by networking community resources and building partnerships with business, industry, government and professional organizations.
