Jacobs Technology and Frederick Community College have united to offer 10 Maryland residential students an incentive to complete their academic program in Emergency Management at Frederick Community College.

One-time completion incentives will be awarded to selected students for up to \$1,000 each. Incentive money awarded will pay for the costs to convert the FEMA IS courses to college credit not to exceed \$1,000 within six months of award. The incentive money will be applied at the point of sale on www.em-study.com. The application opportunity will close December 1, 2014, or upon receipt of the first 100 applicants. Eligibility components will be validated, essay responses scored, and successful applicants will be determined by a panel of academic advisors. Applicants selected will be notified by January 15, 2015.

Eligibility requirements include the following:

1. Must be an Associates of Applied Science Degree (AAS) or Certificate (CERT) seeking student in the Emergency Management Academic Program at Frederick Community College. Applicant must be enrolled in the academic program at the time of incentive application.
2. Proof of Maryland residency.
3. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
4. Complete the application and essay requirements below.
