

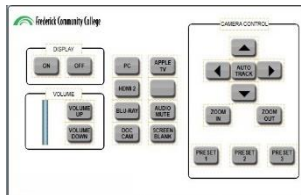
F-112 is equipped with a computer, projector, document camera, Blu-Ray player, Apple TV and an Audio/Visual system with sound. The projection surface is also a whiteboard and can be written on using dry erase markers.

The room is also equipped with ceiling mounted microphones and wall mounted camera for virtual meetings.

- The **instructor computer** can be conveniently positioned being mounted on an adjustable arm.
- If the computer screen is blank, move the mouse to wake it up. If it does not respond, press the power button located on the front of the computer.
- Log in by typing your network name and password.
- **REMEMBER TO LOG OUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED.**

The touch panel controls for the **projector power**, **volume** and **input source** are located on the wall to the right of the instructor console. Wave your hand in front to wake it up.

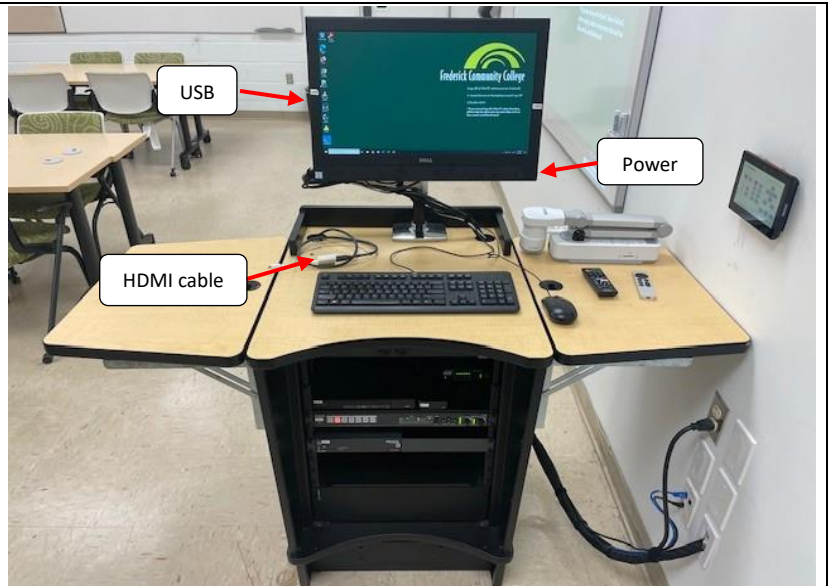
Touching the **Display ON** button will turn on the projector. Select one of the source buttons to display your content to the projector screen.



If you wish to connect other devices to the projector, use the **HDMI** cable on top of the console and select **HDMI** on the touchpanel. Adapters for most laptops are attached to the cable.

Additional USB ports can be located on the front of the computer or the left side of the monitor.

Detailed instructions on how to use the document camera or the wall mounted web camera and ceiling microphones for Teams, Zoom or other remote presentations can be found on a separate instruction sheet.

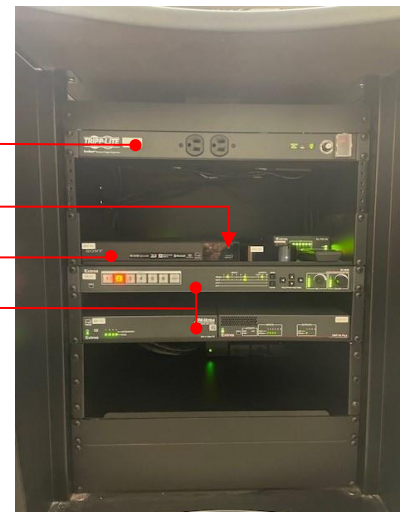


Rack power and additional outlet
