- 1. Scholarship Application
- 2. Personal Statement of your educational and career goals
- 3. Unofficial copies or grade slips from all other colleges and universities attended
- 4. Résumé or listing of your extracurricular and community activities Visit FCC's Career Services website for assistance with resume, if needed: https://www.frederick.edu/student-resources/career-services.aspx
- 5. Evidence of your scholarly and creative activities limit of <u>two items</u> (can include scanned copies of artwork, photos, creative projects, research papers, published material, honors, awards, etc.)
- 6. One or two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff members at the community college
- 7. Transcript Release Form allowing FCC to release your FCC transcript to the University System of Maryland Regent Scholarship Committee: https://app.perfectforms.com/PresentationServer/Form.aspx/Play/WpImAgUI?f=WpImAgUI
- 8. Student must submit the FAFSA in order to be considered for any of the Kelly Regents Scholarships or Grants.
