Applications **cannot** be submitted to the University System of Maryland office through this site.

All student applicants, whether nominated by their institution's Office of the President or self-nominated, should work with their campus's Transfer Services or Scholarship office to coordinate the submission of their application packets. Community College administrators will send application packages directly from their offices to the University System of Maryland scholarship committee via a portal link to be provided to them.

Required Application and Documentation

- 1. Scholarship application form.
- 2. Personal statement of your educational and career goals.
- 3. Transcript Release Form allowing FCC to release your FCC transcript to the University System of Maryland Regent. Copy this URL into your browser to access form: https://app.perfectforms.com/PresentationServer/Form.aspx/Play/WpImAgUl?f=WpImAgUl
- 4. Unofficial transcript copies from all other colleges and universities attended.
- 5. Resume or listing of your extracurricular and community activities. See *Career Services* on frederick.edu for resume guidance.
- 6. Evidence of your scholarly and creative activities limit of **two items** (can include scanned copies of artwork, photos, creative projects, research papers, published material, honors, awards, etc.)
- 7. One or two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff members at Frederick Community College.
- 8. Students must submit the FAFSA to be considered for any Regents Scholarship or Grants with the requirement of "demonstrated financial need."

Please note: Preference will be given to Maryland residents during the scholarship selection process coming from the community colleges.

The deadline for submission of the completed USM Regent Scholarship and Grants applications is 11:59 pm on Monday May 15, 2023.
