Full-time is calculated using 12 credits and is used for students taking 12 or more required credits for their program of study.

Three-quarter-time is calculated using 11 credits and is used for students taking 9 to 11 required credits for their program of study.

Half-time is calculated using 6 credits and is used for students taking 6 to 8 required credits for their program of study.

Less-than-half-time is calculated using 5 credits and is used for students taking less than 6 required credits for their program of study.
