## **Required Documentation**

- 1. Nomination letter from the community college president
- 2. Scholarship Application
- 3. Personal Statement of the student's educational and career goals
- 4. Official copy of the community college transcript we accept password-protected files, secured documents using electronic delivery such as Parchment, or Electronic Transcript sent to the USM Office (FICE code 007959).
- 5. Unofficial copies or grade slips from all other colleges and universities attended
- 6. Résumé or listing of the student's extracurricular and community activities
- 7. Evidence of the student's scholarly and creative activities limit of <u>two items</u> (can include scanned copies of artwork, photos, creative projects, research papers, published material, honors, awards, etc.)
- 8. One or two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff members at the community college
- 9. Please do not submit the application items in folders or binders staples or clips are permitted.

## Please note:

- 1. Preference will be given to Maryland residents during the scholarship selection process.
- 2. Students must submit the FAFSA in order to be considered for any of the Kelly Regents Scholarships or Grants.
- 3. Items with the student's personal information should be sent by more secure means such as password-protected documents, fax, direct mailing or Electronic Transcript.
- 4. Other documentation -- such as letters of nomination, scholarly/creative evidence, or recommendations -- may be sent by fax or by email with attachments.

The deadline for submission of the completed Regents Scholarship applications is June 15, 2021.
