



## **General Information for this Face-to-Face, Online, or Combination Model\***

(\* <u>NEW for fall 2019</u> – Towson University is offering students the opportunity to choose the format for each course that works best for them.)

#### **I. General Program Information**

This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students once they are accepted to the Frederick Community College (FCC) Nursing Program. Admission is competitive and based on completed courses and grade point average (GPA). Students will be enrolled as degree students at FCC and Towson University (TU) and begin to take TU courses during the Nursing Program at FCC. Once the Associate of Science (A. S.) Degree is awarded at FCC, students must take and pass the nursing licensure exam, the NCLEX-RN, and then continue coursework at TU to complete the Bachelor of Science (B. S.) Degree.

Program length is 9 terms, including winter and summer sessions, and it takes approximately 2 ½ years to complete.

FCC courses will be held at the Frederick Community College campus. TU courses will be taken at the TU main campus in Towson, Maryland.

Two degrees will be awarded: A.S. from FCC and B.S. from Towson University (where a <u>minimum of **30 credits** will be required</u> from TU to graduate with the B.S.).

Advisors will be available from both FCC and TU.

Financial aid will be arranged through Towson University Office of Financial Aid.

#### **II. Program Admission Requirements**

- A. Admission to FCC Nursing Program (selective process based on courses completed, GPA, and test scores)
- B. GPA of 3.0 or higher in FCC required admission courses
- C. Additional required courses (completed by the start of the first nursing course) with a C or better:

Chemistry (CHEM 101)

4 credits (must include a lab)

Nutrition (NUTR 200)

3 credits

Also needed for Towson's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree: MATH 120 (Statistics) or MATH 127 (Statistics with Probability).

#### **III. ATB Program Progression**

Students must be successful in <u>all required courses</u> to continue in the ATB option. Students are expected to complete the sequence of study as outlined in the Towson Univ. ATB curriculum plan. Students are required to meet regularly with their TU advisor to review their ATB curriculum plan. Students must successfully complete their associate degree prior to taking NURS 476 and NURS 484. Students must successfully pass the NCLEX-RN exam prior to taking NURS 489 (Practicum).

#### **IV. General Application Procedures**

**Note:** Students applying to the TU ATB Option must first be accepted to the FCC A.S. Degree Nursing Program. Admission to the TU ATB Option is contingent upon admission to FCC's Nursing Program.

### All applications, fees and transcripts must be received by TU by the published deadline.

- 5. Student will be notified by either email and/or letter with admission decision.
