- Conditional Permanent Resident Card (I-151-C)
- Arrival/Departure Record (I-94) from the INS showing any one of the following designations:
- "Refugee"
- "Asylum Granted"
- "Indefinite Parole" and/or "Humanitarian Parole"
- "Cuban/Haitian Entrant"

You are not eligible if you are in the U.S. under one of the following designations:

- F1 or F2 Student Visa
- J1 or J2 Exchange Visitor Visa, or
- G Series Visa (Please contact us for scholarship information for undocumented or international students)

\*The College will accept a legible copy of the original document (through mail, e-mail, or fax) while remote operations are in place due to COVID-19. The student must copy the documents front and back. All copies must be signed and dated by the student and include the statement, "This document was copied from the original citizenship documentation."
