Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be enrolled and currently attending a minimum of one of the following:
 - (1) 3 credit hours in a certificate or degree
 - (2) 1 CE course of at least 24 hours in total length that results in a workforce outcome
 - (3) 60-hour adult education course at the time the fund is being requested
- Student must be experiencing a hardship that jeopardizes his or her ability to remain in school
- Student does not have other resources to meet his or her financial needs
