Reminders for Students Using Veteran Readiness & Employment (Chapter 31)

Know Your Program Requirements and Plan Your Classes¹: Log into your <u>Peoplesoft account</u> to view your Degree Plan and see your remaining certificate or degree requirements. Watch the video: <u>How to Check Degree Plan</u> for instructions. Look at the Pathway for your program in the online <u>academic catalog</u> to see which classes you should take next.

Register for Classes: Register for classes by logging into your <u>PeopleSoft account</u>. Watch the video: <u>*How to Add Courses and Enroll*</u> for instructions. If you will be receiving BAH, refer to the guide below titled: *How to Build a Schedule to Maximize BAH*.

Verify that FCC Veteran & Military Services has authorization from your Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor (VRC) for your classes this semester: If you aren't sure, contact Tricia Morris, FCC's School Certifying Official at <u>TrMorris@frederick.edu</u> or 301-846-2632. If you need authorization, contact your VRC directly and request that they provide authorization in Tungsten.

Check Your Student Email Account for Your Book Voucher: Once you register for classes; FCC VMS verifies VRC authorization and certifies your enrollment with the VA; and books go on sale at the campus Bookstore for the upcoming semester, VMS will email a book voucher, along with instructions on how to use it to purchase books, materials, and supplies, to your <u>student email account</u>. Go to the <u>Bookstore website</u> to see when books go on sale and what books and materials are required for each class.

Log into BlackBoard: Log into your <u>BlackBoard account</u> a day or two prior to the class start date to access online classes and in-person classes that have a companion site in BlackBoard. ***NOTE: The date and time when professors make their classes available to students in BlackBoard is up to their discretion. Do not worry if you do not see a link to your class in BlackBoard prior to the start date. This does NOT mean you are not enrolled. Confirm your enrollment and class schedule by logging into your <u>PeopleSoft account</u>.

How to Build a Schedule to Maximize BAH

This guide is for students using:

- Post 9/11 GI Bill[®] (Chapter 33)
- Veteran Readiness & Employment (Chapter 31) who are also eligible for Post 9/11 GI Bill
- Fry Scholarship

To maximize your BAH, do the following:

- Pay attention to <u>class format</u>! Choose at least one face-to-face or hybrid class that spans the length of the term. For example, if you are taking one 15-week class, one 13-week class, and two 7-1/2 classes, choose a 15-week class OR two back-to-back 7-1/2 classes that are face-to-face or hybrid. The rest can be online or structured remote if you so choose.
- 2. **Understand your rate-of-pursuit (ROP)** and make sure it is 100% if your schedule allows (this is a personal preference and does not work for everyone!). Note the following:
 - a. A student's ROP must be > 50% to receive any BAH
 - b. VA calculates your ROP based on your enrollment on each day of the session/term
 - c. VA prorates BAH payments according to your ROP
