## Checklist for Spouses and Dependents Using Transferred Post 9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33)

Required steps for spouses and dependents using transferred Post 9/11 GI Bill®:

e submit any documents containing personally identifiable information using the <u>Secure Document</u> <a href="mailto:ssion form">ssion form</a> or you may bring documents with you to an in-person intake appointment.
<ul> <li>Submit the following military documents to Veteran and Military Services (VMS):         <ul> <li>a. Certificate of eligibility (COE) and Department of Defense Transfer of Entitlement document</li> <li>i. If you are using your benefit for the first time and have not yet applied for it, fill out VA Form 22-1990e (Application to Use Transferred VA Education Benefits). Submit your COE to Veteran and Military Services once you receive it.</li> <li>ii. Submit your Department of Defense Transfer of Entitlement (TOE) document to expedite your enrollment certification</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Fill out FCC's free online application for admission <u>here</u> .
Submit official transcripts and/or score reports to FCC's Registrar's Office to be evaluated for credit and determine if you are exempt from the reading, writing, and/or math placement tests. For information about how to submit them go <a href="here">here</a> .  a. Submit official transcripts from any colleges and/or universities where you earned credit b. Submit SAT, ACT, AP, or CLEP score reports if they exempt you from taking the placement tests or yield credit [AP and CLEP score reports must be official to be awarded transfer credit]
Submit unofficial copies of college/university transcripts to VMS for advising purposes if possible
Take the placement tests if you are not <u>exempt</u> . For information about how to take the tests go <u>here</u> . For resources that will help you prepare to take each test go <u>here</u> .
Optional: Apply for federal student aid to see if you are eligible to receive a need-based Pell Grant. Please complete any required placement testing AND provide copies of unofficial college transcripts to VMS prior to your appointment (or bring copies with you to an in-person appointment). We do NOT need to have your benefit documentation on file before you register for classes.
